CHRISTMAS – A SEASON OF JOYFUL CELEBRATION

To mark this year's Christmas Celebration the Christian Community, Federal University of Technology, Akure convened together with family and friends for an evening of carols and lessons to commemorate the birth of Jesus Christ. In his homily, the Chaplain, Chapel of Faith, FUTA, Rev. Ademola Adeyi said Christmas is a time of joy and celebration because the birth of Christ is part of God's plan to save the world from sin and death. The Cleric who took his text from Luke 2: 1-14 said the announcement of the coming of Christ by the angels, was the first proclamation of joy to the world in spite of all catastrophe that the devil has wrecked upon the world. He added that the joy Jesus came to bring was permanent and that each time Christmas comes around it is always a time of thoughtful jubilation. He therefore urged the Christian Community to ponder and reflect on the true message of Christmas and rededicate themselves to God and services to mankind.

In a brief remark the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Adebisi Daramola described the carol service, as uplifting memorable and unique. He prayed that God will sustain the congregation throughout the Yuletide season and beyond with God's perfection on everybody in 2016.
