## **FUTA COMMISERATES WITH EMIR OF LAFIA**

A delegation from the Federal University of Technology, Akure, FUTA has paid a condolence visit to the Chancellor, The Emir of Lafia, His Royal Highness Alhaji (Dr) Isa Mustafa, CFR who recently lost some of his aides in a motor accident. The delegation, led by the Deputy Vice Chancellor, Development Professor Tolulope Akinbogun also included the University's Public Relations Officer, Mr. Adegbenro Adebajo.
