IBULE MONARCH PLEDGES TO SUSTAIN COOPERATION WITH FUTA

The traditional ruler of Ibulesoro, one of the host communities, to the Federal University of Technology, Akure (FUTA), Oba Adenibuyan Falowo, the Onibule of Ibule soro has paid a royal visit to the Management of the University.
