## **MANAGEMENT TO BUILD A NET-ZERO ENERGY BUILDING FOR CRET**

Management has thrown its weight behind the Centre for Renewable Energy Technology (CRET) in its quest to construct a Net-Zero building that will generate its own power without the external supply of power energy. The Director of the Centre of Renewable Energy Technology (CRET), Professor Olu Lafe disclosed this at a stakeholders' meeting with Heads of Departments and the representatives of Schools. He said the Net-Zero building is one that powers itself without the supply of power from other sources adding that everything the building uses it generates from its location. He said it is called Net-Zero energy because it has energy sufficiency and everything it needs it generate. He added that the whole process of constructing the building will be done by Futarians drawn from the Schools in the University. He noted that the goal of management is that the project serves as a learning Centre for students and to show the world that this is happening in Nigeria and from FUTA. He seeks for support from stakeholders in actualizing the project.
